



Wild Turkey Woodlands National Award Applications Due October 15, 2009

The NWTF's Wild Turkey Woodlands Award (WTW) is now accepting applications for the 2010 national annual awards. The WTW National Awards recognize participating landowners for their commitment to providing for the needs of wildlife on their land, helping to promote the NWTF mission, involvement in their community and publicly promoting wise conservation.

As we have done in the past, we have a panel of natural resource professionals score each award application. The top scorer is awarded the National Award followed by the second and third place winners that are recognized as the first and second runner up to the National Award. The remaining applicants are ranked and some are chosen to receive the Outstanding Land Steward Award. The WTW National Award will be presented at the NWTF Convention and Sport Show in February, 2010.

Only landowners who are NWTF members are eligible for the award. However, you can complete an application and submit it with your award application. For an NWTF application call 1-800-THE-NWTF or see our web page, www.nwtf.org.

Award applicants are encouraged to submit detailed descriptions and photographs documenting management on their land, activity with their community, and information on their involvement with the NWTF. Application presentation is also considered as part of the scoring process.
