

Kentucky NWTf Hunting Heritage State Super Fund Projects



Since 1985 over \$2,062,540 has been raised and spent by Kentucky chapters on projects within the state. A sampling of these projects is provided below.

Education [\$602,558]

...on educational programs and literature including scholarships, education boxes, 4-H and teacher workshops and educational projects for volunteers and professionals.

Habitat Enhancement [\$499,659]

...on habitat improvement projects that have impacted more than 321,441 acres within the state.



Outreach Events [\$379,371]

...to introduce youth, women and people with disabilities to outdoor activities, conservation and hunting through JAKES, Women in the Outdoors and Wheelin' Sportsmen. Sponsored 754 outreach events throughout the state.

Turkey Restoration [\$102,770]

...to trap and transfer turkeys within the state including the purchase of trapping equipment such as nets, rockets and rocket charges, and to reimburse other states for expenses related to the trap and transfer of 200 donated turkeys.

Hunting Heritage [\$98,450]

...to protect and promote the hunting tradition including contributions to the U.S. Sportsmen's Alliance and the National Shooting Sports Foundation.

Rewards [\$45,683]

...to protect wild turkeys and other wildlife through support of state sponsored reward programs, the printing of reward signs and reward payments.

Land Purchase [\$40,000]

...to purchase 800 acres of land or conservation easements to preserve wildlife habitat and provide additional hunting areas.

Research [\$19,465]

...on wild turkey research including purchasing equipment related to research such as radio telemetry equipment.

Habitat Enhancement

Goal Expand and support prescribed fire efforts statewide on state, federal and privately owned lands through implementation and education during the next five years.

Goal Promote and increase active forest management strategies to complete on public and private lands in Kentucky.

Goal Contract work with state and federal agencies to enhance nesting and brood-rearing cover in grassland and forested habitats identified in Kentucky's public land system.

Goal Increase early successional habitat on 5,000 acres during the next five years across public, private and reclaimed lands.

Hunter Access

Goal Support strategic land acquisition for new public hunting lands in Kentucky.

Goal Promote public land access and hunting in state, federal and local land management plans.

Goal Promote legislation and programs that preserve hunting and/or reduce the threat of the urbanization of private lands.

Goal Work with corporate partners and other industrial landowners to provide hunting opportunities in Kentucky.

Wild Turkey Research

Goal Identify and support viable wild turkey research projects with state and federal conservation agencies and local universities, and secure funding to support this research.

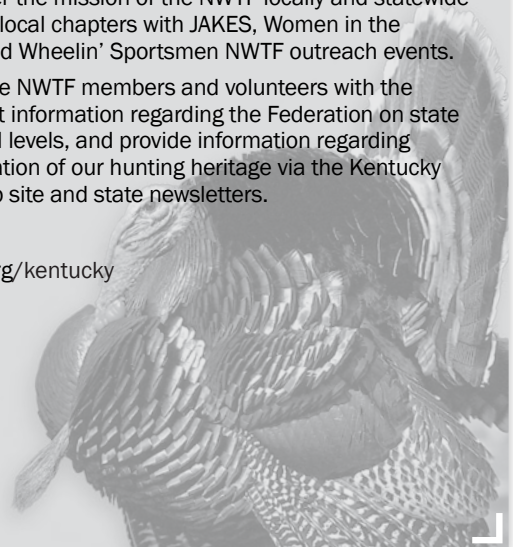
Goal Support and justify new, science-based research that helps determine wild turkey production rates, declines and distributions in the state.
